The goal is NOT to recruit transfer students away from their existing program or campus, but instead, work in collaboration with their existing plans. **These meetings are mandatory and will be essential to the success of these fairs.** At our first fair we will all have a little more time for an official welcome and group introductions along with the local campus update. Thank you for your understanding and respect of this request. Your on-time attendance shows appreciation and respect to the hosting campus. Thank you!
- **DOOR PRIZES |** Each of the fairs will have Door Prize Drawings throughout each fair. This is a time when you can promote your institution even more by giving away a T-Shirt, Water Bottle, Notepad, etc. with your logo on it; however, other gift ideas related to education are also welcome! We encourage this and hope you will be able to participate by bringing 7 door prizes to participate in each of the door prize drawings at each fair. And, lastly, this year you are also welcome to have giveaways for students attending the fair as well if you would like. Again, this is not required, but if you would like to share promotional educational items you are welcome.
- **SITE THANK YOU'S |** Each of the Tribal Colleges hosting a fair have worked very hard to make this a welcoming and successful event for you and your institution. They are very excited to have you part of this year's events! As a tradition, many of these campuses will honor you with a gift, lunch, and/or traditional welcome, as it is customary to share a gift as a sign of respect.
